Science Day Activities

Activities:

- c. Volcano in sand pit

- e. Milk and soap

Brief Description

- -Using water, shaving foam and food colouring the children will observe how a cloud fills with liquid and then produces rain.
- -The children will explore oil and water and how they do not mix and what happens when you add another component.
- -The chemical reaction between vinegar and baking soda.
 - -The children will mix cornflour and water to observe properties.
- -The children will add drops of dye to milk and observe the effect of adding soap.
